Election of Officers

For the 2011 BCHA season, all board positions are up for re-election. Below is a summary of the responsibilities of each office:

President: The President is responsible for holding monthly meeting in January, February and March according to the by-laws. Extra meetings are also scheduled in the spring and summer months to prepare for club shows and activities. The President is also responsible for relaying club business to all members and preparing all needed materials for club activities. The President will also be responsible for helping secure club sponsorships.

Vice President: Shall assist the President in above listed activities. The Vice President will also preside over all meetings and activities shall the President be absent or otherwise able to fulfill the role of President. The Vice President will also be responsible for helping secure club sponsorships.

Secretary: Shall be present at meetings in order to keep record of business. Possible other responsibilities could include assisting President with newsletter and website. The Secretary will also be responsible for helping secure club sponsorships.

Treasurer: The treasurer will be responsible for all monies brought in by the club. The treasurer shall provide a report for each meeting to keep all officer and board members up to date on club monies. The Treasurer will also be responsible for getting change for club activities, depositing monies and handling payback at club open shows. Any financial accounts shall have two (2) board members attached, preferably the President and Treasurer. The Treasurer will also be responsible for helping secure club sponsorships.

Board Members: Board members are expected to attend board meetings regularly. They are also responsible for assisting with sub-committees (i.e. year end awards, car show, etc.) and also responsible for assisting run open shows. Board Members will also be responsible for helping secure club sponsorships.

This is because Boone County will be hosting the Area VI horse show that Saturday, June 25th.
